

PGAG Meeting Minutes

April 10, 2004

- Attendees:

- Meeting was called to order by Jojo at 7:15 PM
- Meeting Minutes taken by Al Ray

- Jojo reviewed the 2nd Asian Golf Tournament report. Received kudos from the Chinese and Thai golf associations.
- Dave and Ben reviewed the PGAG Treasurer's financial report.
- Jojo presented check to Metty Pellicer for the JBP endowment.

- The entire group discussed lessons learned from the Asian Tournament:
 1. The registration sign could have been placed at a better location
 2. Selling of mulligans/door prizes could have been better
 3. Too much expenses incurred on loot bag.
 4. Not enough tables during the banquet.
 5. On future tournaments, eliminate middleman when negotiating with the Golf Club. Signed contract a must.

- The group clarified that the official PGAG season is from March – November.
- The 2004 membership fees are due on May 15, the next PGAG tournament.
- The 2005 and future membership fees are due on the first event in March.
- Renewal fees are \$10, although this could change when the PGAG joins the Georgia State Golf Association (GSGA) in order to obtain USGA Handicaps next year (see handicapping discussion)

- Jojo reviewed the 2004 PGAG schedule of events.
 - o May 15 – PGAG monthly tournament
 - o June 19 – Augusta golfers tournament
 - o July 31 – PGAG First Annual John B Pellicer Memorial Invitation Tournament – a perpetual trophy will be awarded
 - o August – missing from the list – to be determined
 - o September 25 – JBP Presidents Cup (Atlanta vs. Augusta) – to be played in Augusta this year.
 - o October 16 – PGAG Championship – tentative
 - o November 20 – Final PGAG tournament of the year – tentative

- Jojo also mentioned the following events and encouraged PGAG members to participate:
 - o April 18 – Sarong Bangui of Georgia Annual Golf Tournament

- September 4-5 PIBNA golf tournament in Boston
- The group discussed a fund raising event that will benefit the JBP endowment this year.
 - Jojo suggested a dinner dance on June 26.
 - Metty suggested combining the dinner dance with an auction-type fund raising.
 - Metty and Marites to come up with a date this year that will not conflict with any Filipino-sponsored events. June 26 is not a good date.
 - In addition to Metty and Marites, Jun and Al Ray will assist in the planning of this project.
 - All proceeds for this project will go to the JBP endowment this year.
 - The recipients of future PGAG fund-raising events will be determined by the PGAG.
- Ben will look at getting discounts at a number of Golf Courses, leveraging the PGAG membership.
- The following PGAG members were appointed to review the PGAG By-Laws and present to the group:
 - Cas
 - Boboy
 - Metty
- Jojo discussed the PGAG Membership Incentive Program. It was tentatively agreed upon by those present to award the following points. This is subject to review:
 - All participants to every PGAG tournament will get 5 points
 - First place gets additional 3 points
 - Second place gets 2 points
 - Third place gets 1 point
 - At the end of the season, the member with the most points gets prizes. Suggestions were a \$25 gift certificate and free membership for the upcoming year. To be finalized.
- Al Ray briefed the group on handicapping.
 - It was decided that the PGAG would pursue USGA Handicap Indexes in 2005.
 - For the remainder of 2004, we will follow the existing way of calculating handicaps.
 - Handicap indexes will be recalculated for the Sarong Bangui tournament (04/18/2004), using scores from 2003 and 2004 only.
