MGA KABABAYAN:

The Municipality of Imus was declared under State of Calamity due to typhoon Milenyo. A total of Fifteen Million Pesos (P 15,000,000.00) was readily made available to respond to the immediate needs of the people of Imus. Briefly we have allocated Seven Million Pesos (P 7,000,000.00) for relief goods, Two Million Pesos (P 2,000,000.00) for private infrastructure and medical assistance, Four Million Pesos (P 4,000,000.00) for public infrastructure and Two Million Pesos (P 2,000,000.00) for agriculture.

The calamity fund that we made available will not suffice the much needed support for our KABABAYAN to be able to return to their normal life. Let me take this opportunity to appeal to your kind heart to solicit donation for the rehabilitation program we are undertaking.

I will be with you from October 4 until October 10 to share our experience during the super typhoon. I will appreciate if I can facilitate upon my return all the support that can be made possible.

Let me take this opportunity to also make an appeal for your support for our newly constructed Lying-in Hospital in Medicion IC. We will need the following to expedite the opening of the medical service available to our people.
